

## Christmas Houses – Draw date December 3, 2024

Inspiration quilt - [Suburbs Christmas Quilt & Free Tree Block Pattern -](#)

Block size 6.5 inches by 9.5 inches unfinished (6" X 9" finished)



### Colourway

- Christmas greens and reds for house body and house peak.
- White or light blue for sky background
- Dark colours for house doors

### House body

2 strips 2.5" X 6.5" of house body fabric

1 square 2.5" X 2.5" of house body fabric

1 strip 2.5" X 4.5" of dark colored door fabric

Attach the 2.5" square to the door strip.

Attach the 6.5" strips to either side of the strip with the door fabric

House top and sky (flying geese)

1 strip 3.5" X 6.5" of house top fabric

2 squares 3.5" of sky fabric

Alternatively, you can make four house tops and sky at a time if you use one of the four at time flying geese methods in the links below.

**TUTORIAL:** There are many tutorials online for making flying geese. Choose one that makes a 3" x 6" finished flying goose. Here are 3 options:
