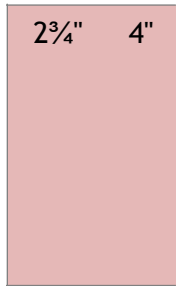


Cath Phillips's Gift Card Holders

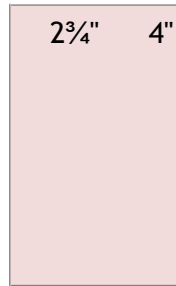

Cut:

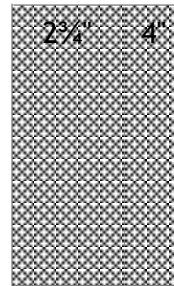
2 each
Outside Fabric



4 each
Lining Fabric



3 only
Fusible Web



✂️ Cut fusible web
a scant 2 3/4" x 4"

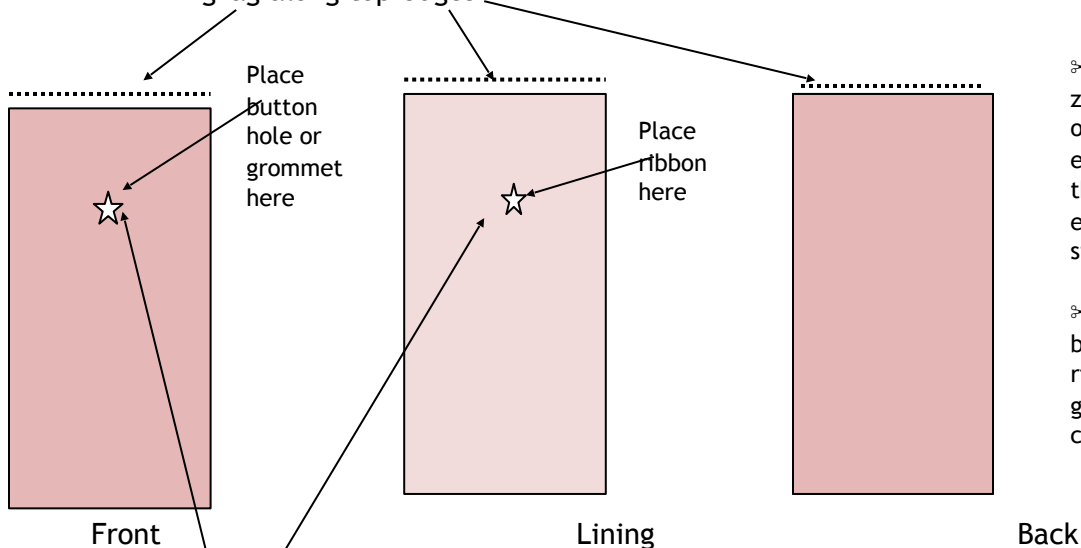
✂️ If you want to quilt or bead the front or back covers, do it now before you fuse

Fuse:

- 2 outside fabrics to 2 lining fabrics
- 2 lining fabrics together

Prepare sections

- Use a medium zigzag with close stitch length
- Zigzag along top edges



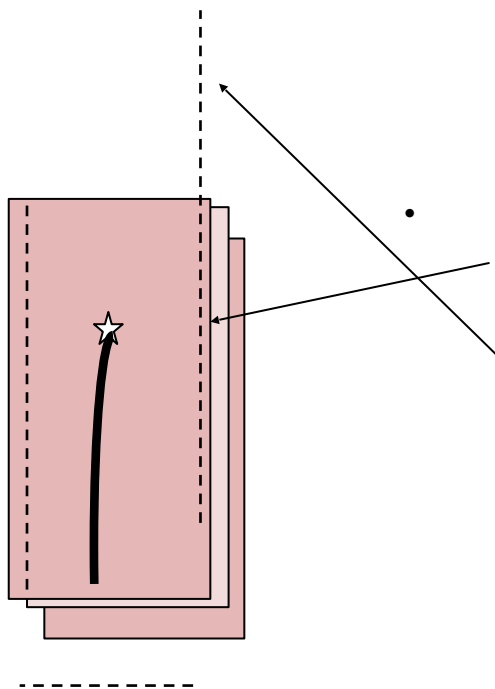
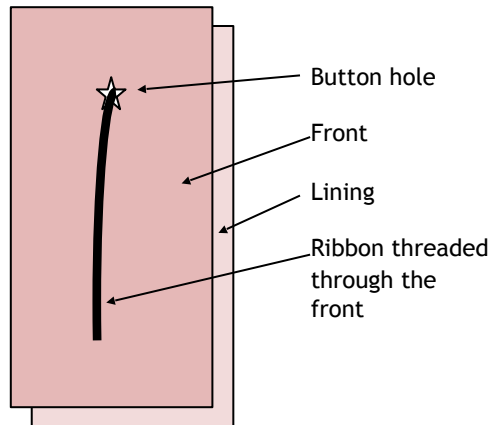
✂️ Let the last zigzag stitch fall off the edge of each piece so that it is enclosed in the stitching

✂️ Choose a buttonhole for ribbon or a grommet for cording

- Mark a spot 1" from the top and in the centre of the 2 3/4" width on one of your fused outside fabric pieces (this will become the front) and on the fused lining piece
- Centre your opening on this spot on the front piece and insert your buttonhole or grommet
- Centre a 12" ribbon on this spot on the lining piece letting it hang straight down. ZigZag over the ribbon about 1/2" from the top of the ribbon so that it is secure.

Complete Card Holder

- Thread ribbon through buttonhole on the front so that it now hangs out of the buttonhole on the front piece.
- Baste front and lining pieces together using a narrow zigzag stitch on bottom and sides only



• Baste all three pieces together on bottom and sides only.

- Position back with outside fabric facing out.
- Use a narrow zigzag stitch.
- Match bottoms and sides.
- Leave a long thread at one end.
- Lockstitch or back stitch at each opening

✂ Leaving a long thread at one end when you baste the

- Finish seams by either couching yarn/cording or by using a basic satin zigzag, Lock or backstitching at top on both sides. Trim threads/yarns.
- Insert a card to force the ribbon down and pull on the ribbon a few times. Determine where the embellishments should be placed on the cord/ribbon. Embellish ribbon as desired, knotting and trimming the end.
