

Guidelines for Donation Quilts (February 2019)

Members are encouraged to provide at least one donation quilt each year.

Please hand completed items to the Donations Committee after Show and Tell.

OVQG labels are available from the Library or the Donation Committee at no cost and should be sewn onto the back of the quilt.

OVQG donates to the following organizations:
Neonatal Intensive Care Unit at KGH, Tiny Bundles at the Food Bank, Kids Count, Central Okanagan Hospice Association, SPCA and Salvation Army.

Check with the Donations Committee to see what special projects are being undertaken. Kits and batting are available.

General construction guidelines:

- Strong, durable, washable cotton fabric
- Strong construction methods
- Double-fold binding (by machine or by hand) must be securely attached
- Attach a donation label
- No invisible thread or raw edges
