

HAPPY VILLAGE TUTORIAL - Fabric & Supplies List

Color Palette: Bright Multi-Color

Fabric:

Minimum of 10 colors* - look for "solid-like" / NO busy prints, of varying color values

1. Dark purple	2. Lavender
3. Dark blue	4. Medium blue
5. Light blue	6. Red
7. Yellow	8. Orange
9. Deep pink	10. Medium green

*Ten colors are the minimum needed to cover the surface of a 16.5" square. Please feel free to add and substitute colors where desired.

Buildings: Cut one 6.5" square from each of the 10 colors

Rooftops: Cut one 6.5" x 2" rectangle from each of the 10 colors, or from fabrics of your choice

Fabric suggestions for rooftops & windows:

- Stripes
- Small scale shingle prints
- Architectural prints
- Ornate designs
- Black & white prints
- Plaids

Other Supplies:

- 17.5" x 17.5" square of 100% cotton batting. Will get smaller after quilting (so it can be cut to size at 16.5" x 16.5")
- Rotary cutter and cutting mat (medium size)
- Rotary cutter with wave, scallop, or pinking blade
- Rulers for rotary cutting (small and large)
- Marking pencil or chalk (optional)
- Large and small fabric scissors
- Water based fabric glue with long applicator tip – fast drying kind
- Pins for basting (or basting thread)
- Tweezers with a long handle
- Foam core board & pins (to carry around and pin your design onto it)

Later Supplies:

- ½ meter tulle – a very fine netting often used for veils. Audition several colors as this is a personal choice.
- 18" x 18" black felt / 2 meters multi-colored yarn OR ½ meter backing fabric / ¼ meter binding
- Sewing machine – with walking foot and/or darning foot
- Variegated multi-colored thread for machine stitching; cotton or rayon (use hand quilting thread for hand stitching)
