

This fun tree block is made improvisationally, and you end up with two blocks once you're done.
COLOURWAY:
Fabric 1: low volume
Fabric 2: any modern green fabric so we have a variation in our forest colours. Avoid overt Christmas patterns so that this quilt can be enjoyed year-round and by folks who may not celebrate Christmas.

Fabric 3: brown for tree trunk

NOTES:
Because the blocks are made improvisationally, you won't end up with a set size of block. Just trim your blocks so that they are the largest rectangle possible (or leave untrimmed). Whoever wins them can trim and/or add strips as necessary - the beauty of a bunch of scrappy blocks is that this will look wonderful in the final composition!
