

# PHOTO TO FABRIC

There are several different methods for printing photos on fabric.

## Before printing:

1. Choose a good photo. Most require some editing.
  - crop edges to focus on the main topic of the photo
  - if water, a building or tree is in the photo, straighten the photo.
2. Enhance the colour, sharpen, delete distractions and other adjustments if your program allows.

## METHOD 1

Purchase ready prepared fabric sheets

1. Print, dry 24 hours
2. Soak in Bubble Jet Rinse for 5 minutes.

## METHOD 2

1. Wash good quality 100% cotton fabric then soak in Bubble Jet Set, squeeze excess out, dry and press thoroughly
2. Cut into piece slightly bigger than 8.5" x 11"
3. Peel backing off 8.5' x 11" mailing label
4. Press mailing label to **WRONG** side of pressed fabric
5. Square up to 8.5" x 11"
6. Place in printer. Print using one of the best choices for your printer. Make sure you have piece sitting correctly to print on fabric. You may want to do test print on paper.
7. Remove from printer tray. Dry for 24 hours
8. Remove label – place label on it's original backing for reuse
9. Soak in Bubble Jet Rinse for 5 minutes.

## METHOD 3

1. As above, but replace mailing label with freezer paper.
2. Iron the freezer paper onto the wrong side of the fabric.
3. Press and press and press some more, making certain all bubbles are pressed out before squaring up.
4. Print, dry and soak in bubble jet set as above.
