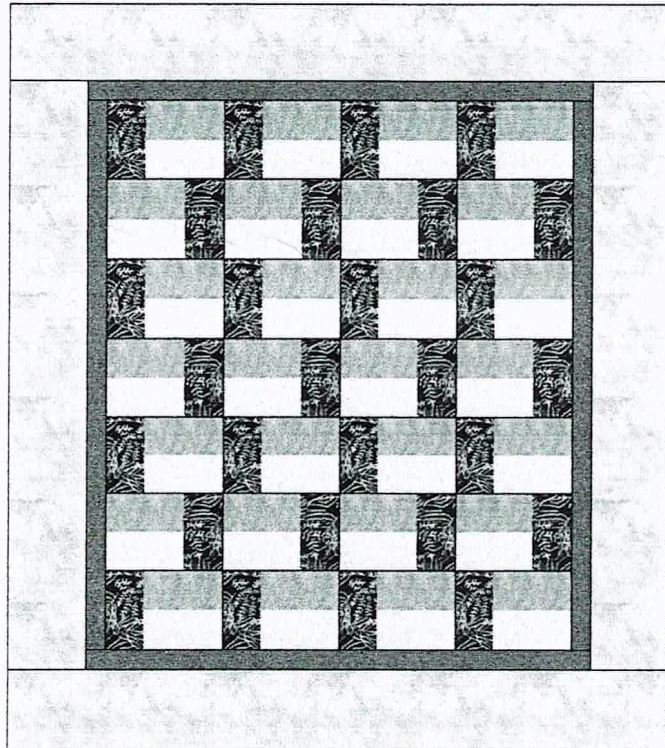


Preemie pattern VI (34" by 38")



Fabric requirements:

Blocks - .3 M each of three different fabrics. Should have some contrast between them.

Inner Border - .2 M

Outer Border - .5 M

Blocks – From each block fabric, cut 4 strips 2.5" by width of fabric. Join two contrasting strips of

fabric to make one strata set.



Make four identical strata. Sub cut these at 4.5" intervals to make 28 sections. From the remaining block fabric strips, cut 28 rectangles 4.5" by 2.5". Sew one rectangle to one end of a



strata section to make these two blocks: Make 16 of one type and 12 of the other.

Using the same type of block across each row, arrange blocks 4 across by 7 down, alternating block types for each row as shown above. Join the blocks into rows, pressing the seams between blocks in opposite directions for each row. Join the rows.

Inner Border – Cut 4 strips 1.5" by width of fabric. Sew one strip to each side of quilt center then sew the remaining two strips to the top and bottom.

Outer Border – Cut 4 strips 4.25" by width of fabric. Sew one strip to each side of quilt center then sew the remaining two strips to the top and bottom.
