

Scrap Dance Mystery Quilt

Part 1

Begin by cutting out the following squares

Scrappy Fabrics	Table 20x20	Baby 30x30	Lap 40x50	Twin 80x90
2 1/2" squares	36	85	180	571
3" squares	16	36	80	252

Background Fabric - recommended to be one fabric not a mix

2 1/2" squares	32	68	160	500
3" squares	16	36	80	252

Note * - if you are really good at making half square triangles, you can cut 2 7/8" squares instead of 3" but it is easier to make them somewhat larger and then size them up perfectly

Match up each 3" scrappy square with a 3" background square, right sides together. Draw a diagonal line on the back of each background square and sew a 1/4" seam on both sides of the line. Cut on the line to form the half square triangle units.

Press towards the scrappy fabric - square up to 2 1/2"

Fabric Requirements

Scrappy	1/2 yd	1 yd	1 3/4 yd	3 3/4 yd
Background	1/2 yd	1 yd	1 3/4 yd	3 3/4 yd

Scrappy Border idea - while cutting out the above squares, cut some additional odd scraps into 3" tall pieces of varying widths - you can use these as leaders and enders while constructing your blocks.
