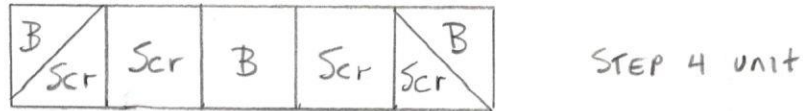


## Mystery Quilt Exchange

### Part 7

The secret to this quilt is in step 4. Remember how we made more of these than in any other step?

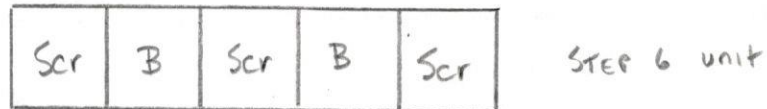
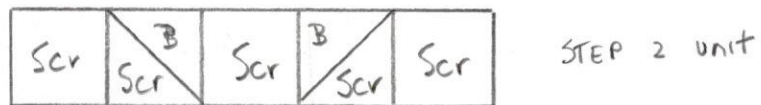


Well, the reason is that there are **TWO** different blocks and both use the same sequence.

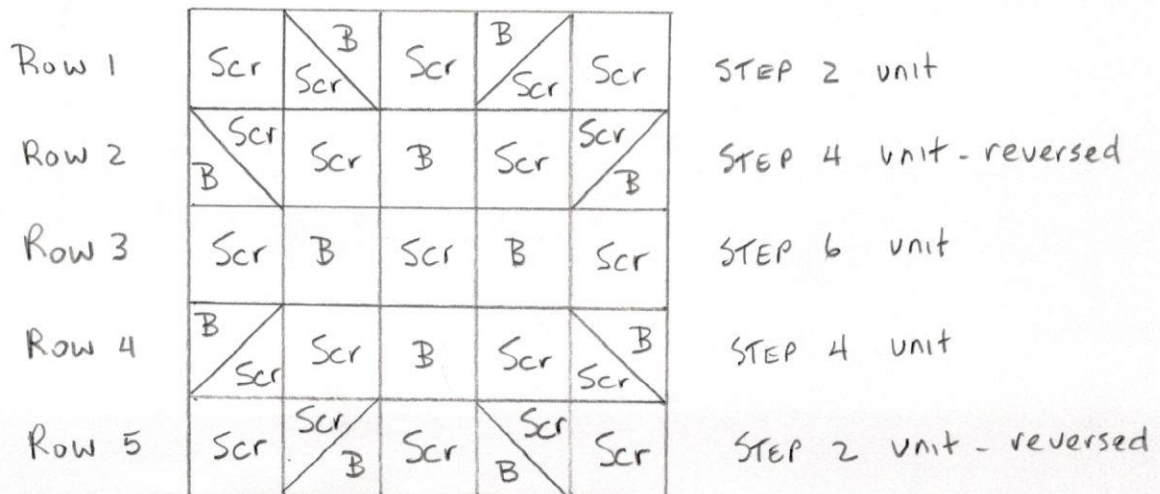
Half right side up and Half upside down. Both are used in the inner rows but positioned differently. For the other steps you'll turn one of the other units upside down on each block too.

### In Block A

The step 4 unit is in Rows 2 & 4, with Row 2 upside down. The step 2 unit is in Rows 1 & 5 with row 5 upside down. Using Step 2, 4, & 6 units, construct Block A.



The number will depend on the number of Step 6's you have. That is the centre of the block.

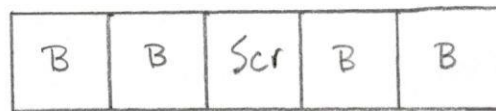


In **Block B**

In this block, steps 3, 4 & 5 units are used to construct **Block B**. The number will depend on the number of step 5 units you have. In **Block B**, the step 4 unit is also used in rows 2 & 4 with row 4 upside down.

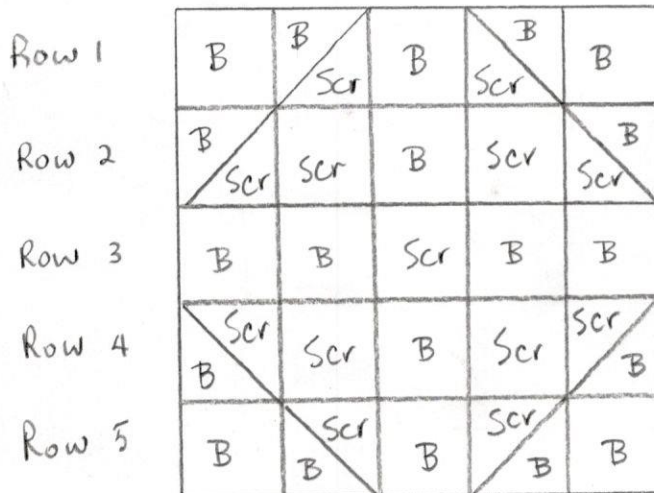


Step 3 unit

Add the step 5 unit in the middle and the step 3 units to the top and bottom. Here is **Block B**.
