

SmARTies Project

- 1) There are nine (9) paint chips of varying size and colours in your envelope. They were collected in Ottawa, Toronto, Calgary and Kelowna.
- 2) From all of these colours you are to choose three (3) that you wish to include in your piece. You may add as many other colours/patterns as you wish but you must include all three of the colours you select and be able to show the chip colours in your piece of work.
- 3) In addition there is a sheet with geometric shapes in your envelope.
- 4) From all of these shapes you are to choose one (1) that you wish to include in your piece. You can have as many shapes in your piece as you wish but somewhere in your piece you will need to include one of the shapes on this sheet. Or your overall piece could be made into one of these shapes.
- 5) You may create whatever type of work that appeals to you i.e. traditional quilt, art work, felt work, embroidery, wool work, table runner, wall hanging, clothing, beadings, applique, jewellery, etc. There is no limitation as to the type of work.
- 6) You may embellish/quilt your work in whatever manner you would like.
- 7) Your work can be whatever size you wish.
- 8) Your finished product is due at the smARTies meeting on January 19, 2016.
- 9) You will be asked to present your piece individually, show the colours you chose, the shape you selected and give a description about how you worked the colours/shape into your piece and why/how you created the piece you did.
