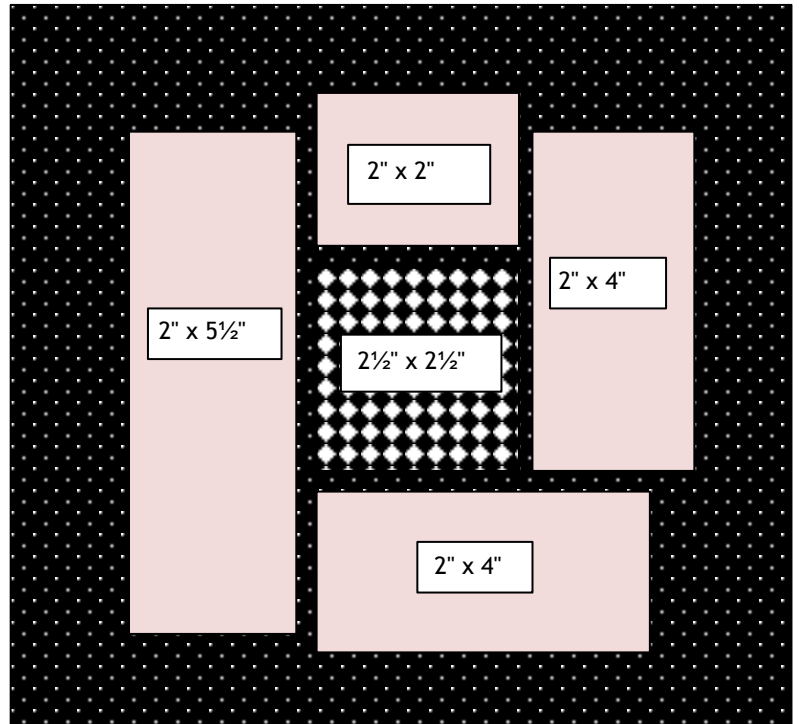


# Sue Campbell's Coasters

Using flip 'n' sew method, construct top on a double layer of 6½" squares of batting, log cabin style. See dimensions in diagram.

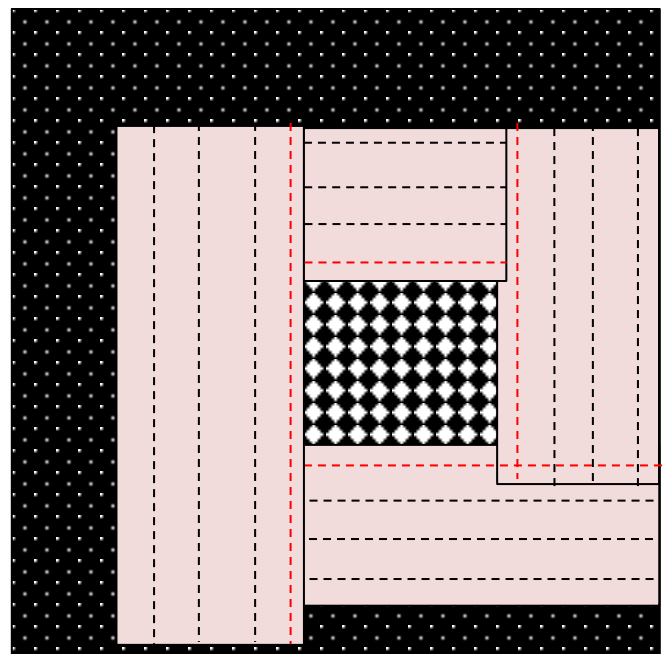
Note: Backing is unnecessary at this point because you will add it later envelope-style

Try using some of the fabric we created in Sue's "What If" tutorial for the centre block.



Quilt around the outside pieces starting 1/8" away from the inside edge (see red line)

Trim excess batting to 5½" x 5½" (diagram shows right and bottom sides trimmed away)



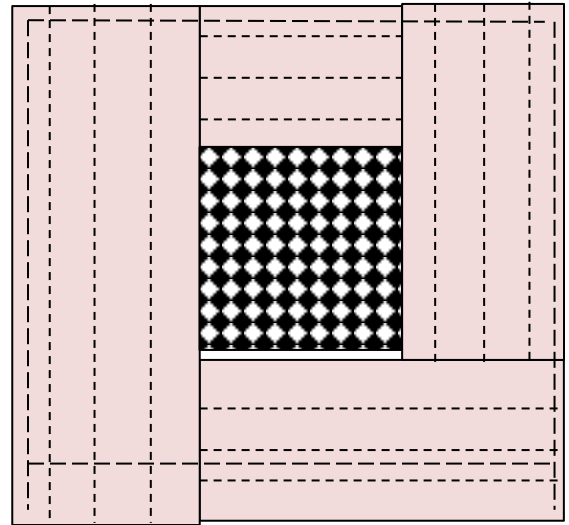
Cut a 5½" square of backing fabric.

Place it on top of your coaster, right sides together. Pin if necessary

Sew a ¼" seam around the outside, leaving a 2" opening for turning it inside out.

Trim corners. Carefully trim away batting if necessary. Turn inside out, press and turning in the open edges.

Topstitch around all four sides to close the opening



Tip:

Sue recommends using a walking foot to sew through the many layers of fabric.
