

Supplies for Flying Geese, November 14, 2017, if you wish to sew

For 3"x6" finished size blocks

**1. Connector Corner Geese**

Goose - 1 rectangle  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

Background/Sky - 2 squares  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

**2. Strip Sewn Geese**

Geese - 2 or more rectangles  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

Sky - 4 or more squares (2 per goose)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

**3. No Waste 4 at a time Flying Geese**

Geese - 1 square  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{4}$ "

Sky - 4 squares  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $3\frac{7}{8}$ "

**4. 4 at a time trimmable Flying Geese**

Geese - 1 square 7" x 7"

Sky - 1 square  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ "

**5. 3-D Flying Geese**

Goose - 1 rectangle  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

Sky - 2 squares  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

Other Supplies:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot pedal and manual
- Thread to match or neutral - wind bobbin at home to save time
- Rotary cutter, small cutting mat, pins, marker (like Frixion), ruler (at least 12"), flying geese ruler if you have one, seam ripper, thread snips, and other normal sewing things you would take to a class
