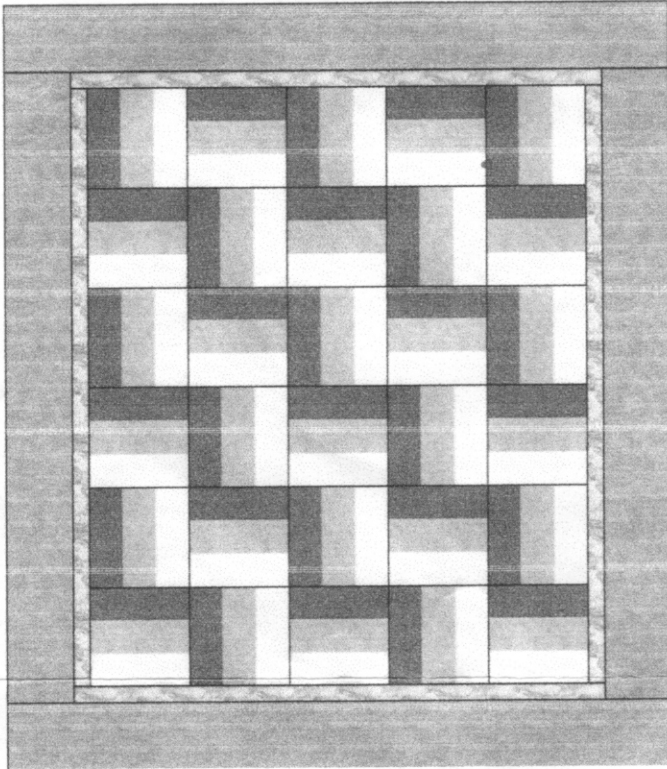


Triple Rail Fence crib size (40" by 46")



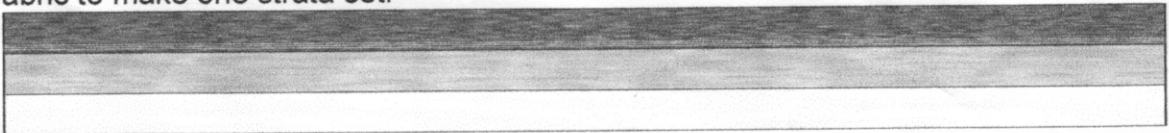
Fabric requirements:

Blocks - .4 M each of three different fabrics. Should have some contrast between them.

Inner Border - .2 M

Outer Border - .5 M

Blocks – From each fabric, cut 5 strips 2.5" by width of fabric. Join one strip of each fabric to make one strata set.



Make five identical strata. Sub cut these at 6.5" intervals to make 30 blocks. Arrange blocks 5 across by 6 down, turning every other block as shown above. Join the blocks into rows, pressing the seams between blocks in opposite directions for each row. Join the rows.

Inner Border – Cut 4 strips 1.5" by width of fabric. Sew one strip to each side of quilt center then sew the remaining two strips to the top and bottom.

Outer Border – Cut 4 strips 4.5" by width of fabric. Sew one strip to each side of quilt center then sew the remaining two strips to the top and bottom.
