

'OH CHRISTMAS TREE'

Block size for larger tree - 8.5" x 8.5"

Block size for skinny tree - 8.5" x 4.5"

Can be a green tree on white background

or

White tree on green background

Leaving at least 1 1/4" of space between top tip of tree to top edge of large rectangle, sew long edge of large rectangle to right side of tree first.

Press to either side and trim.

Sew remaining large rectangle to left side of tree, matching tops of background fabric. Press to one side.

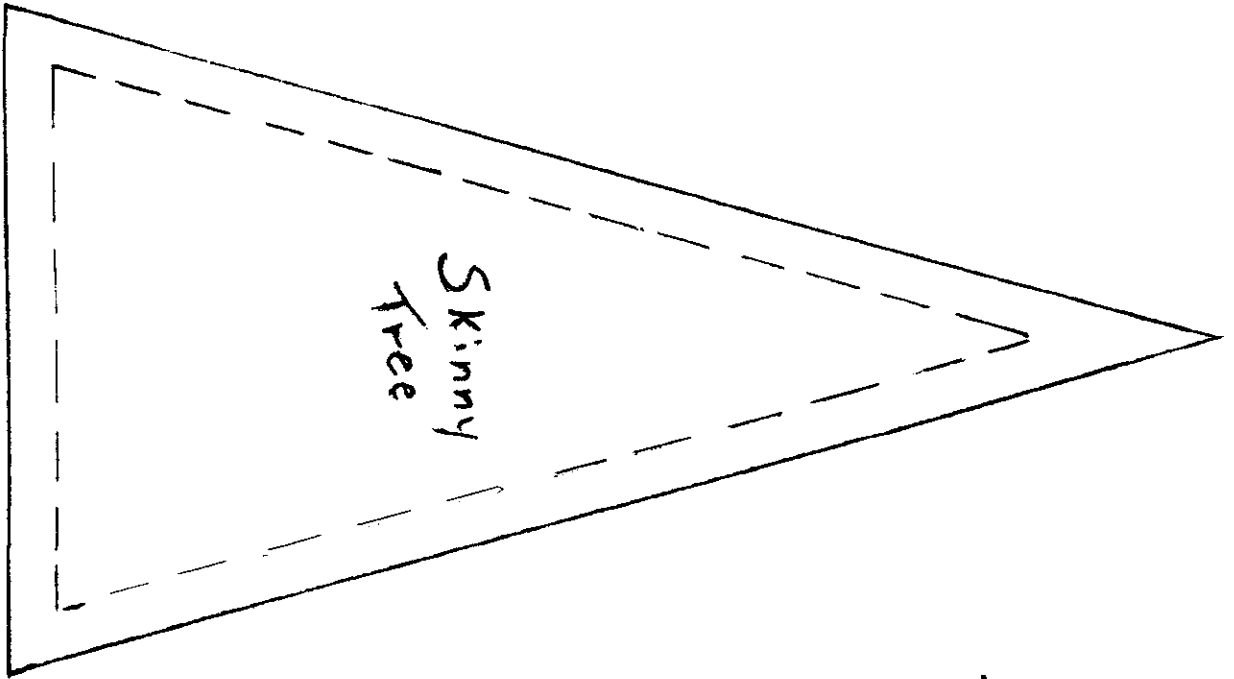
Trim so that bottom of tree and background fabric on both sides are level.

Sew small rectangles to either side of tree trunk, and press to either side.

Matching (approximately) to center, sew this bottom pieced section to tree.

Press to either side.

Leaving at least 3/4" from top tip of tree to top edge of block, trim block to be 8.5" square.



Tree trunk:
(brown)

- for larger tree cut 1 rectangle

$2\frac{1}{2}$ " \updownarrow x $1\frac{3}{4}$ " \leftrightarrow

- for skinny tree cut 1 rectangle

3" \updownarrow x 2" \leftrightarrow

Background Fabric:

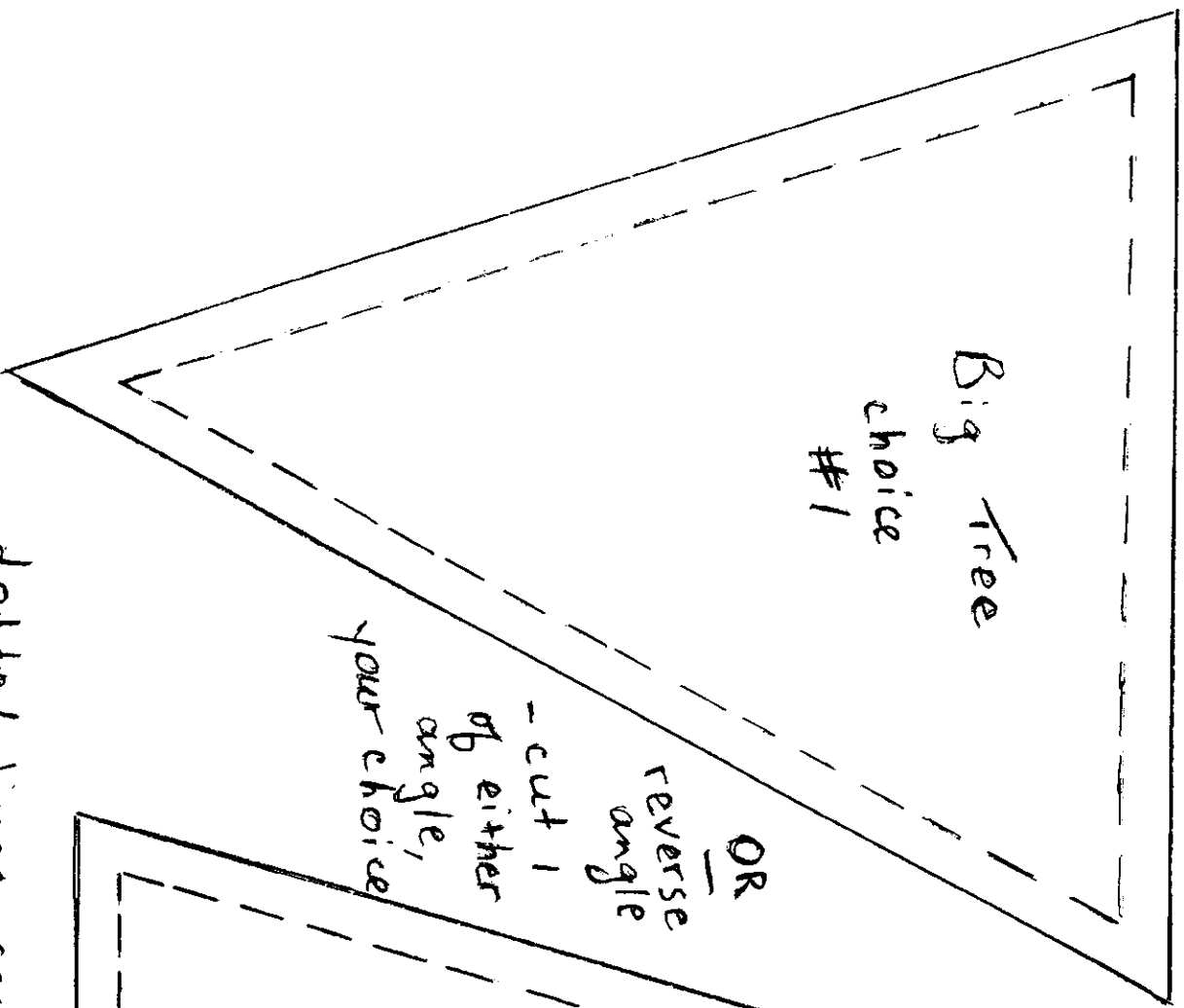
Larger tree - cut 2 6" x 11"

Skinny tree - cut 2 $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10"

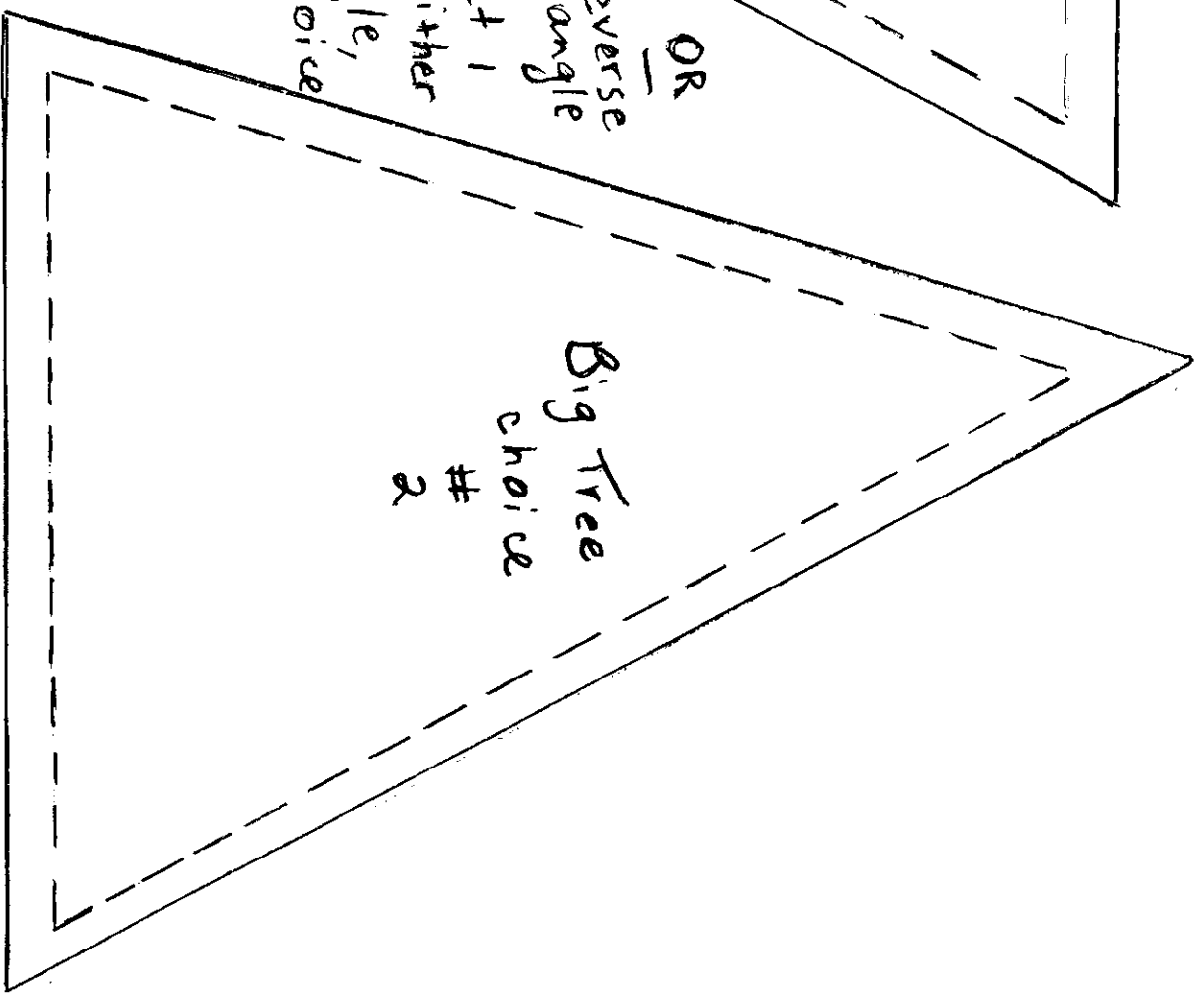
Also, cut a smaller
rectangle for either side
of tree trunk:

Larger tree - cut 2 $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

Skinny tree - cut 2 $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "
