

## Modern Traditionalism

- Is a very personal interpretation of a traditional block
- It's important to try and fail in order to free yourself from the blocks you learned how to quilt with
- Learn how to try a design either on paper with coloured paper or with the fabric you have chosen
- Colour is an important consideration & will change a block quickly as will the colour of your thread
- 1** - The block can be altered for just the block or make the altered block the whole quilt
- 2** - An easy way to alter a block is to repeat shapes within the block
- 3** - Or you can add scale and enlarge parts of the block
- 4** - You can also repeat the block in different sizes
- If your practice blocks don't appeal to you, keep them to cut up & use in other improve projects
