CHRISTMAS STOCKINGS - WOMEN'S SHELTER - 2014

Foundation Piecing method:

From the pattern cut one muslin or other fabric for foundation. Sew strips, etc. to foundation (flip and sew method) until foundation is covered and strips extend slightly beyond the edge. Press. Baste around edge to hold pieces in place, then trim to stocking shape.

Lay this piece foundation-side down onto lining fabric, right side up. Cut out lining and baste to stocking front, leaving top open. Trim lining to stocking shape.

Lay this 3-layered piece front side down onto right side of stocking back. Pin. Sew with $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam around edges, leaving top open. Trim edges.

Turn inside out, turning only the back piece. This will result in the right sides out and the lining sides in, and the seam enclosed. Press.

Cuff:

Measure the top of the stocking, double this measurement and add ½" for seam. Sew short ends together, right sides together. Turn, press seam. Fold with wrong sides together to make a circle. Place the circle inside the stocking, raw edges even. If using a hanging loop, insert it at the back seam of the stocking, hanging down inside the stocking, and between the stocking and the cuff. Sew cuff on with ½" to ½" seam. Turn cuff to the outside, press. Edge-stitch cuff if you wish.

Hanging loop can be 5" fabric tube folded in half, rick rack, ribbon, yarn, etc.

One-piece Front method:

Cut 2 lining pieces, right sides together. Cut front outer piece and lay wrong side onto lining wrong side. Baste around the edges leaving top open. Lay this 3-layered piece onto backing, right side of front outer fabric to right side of backing fabric. Pin. Stitch around edges, leaving top open. Trim backing to shape. Turn inside out as above. Attach cuff as above.

but outside the line 4" Add a generous 4 " (again) all around if using loose woven or uphokstery-type tabric.

Pattern in 3 Parts.
Attach "A" to "A" and "B" to B" lines.
